Nominators and voters must be enrolled students of ECU.

BALLOT PAPERS**Draw for position on Ballot papers**

Candidates appear on the Ballot paper in order established by a Ballot Draw to be held at 1pm Mon 3 October at Joondalup Guild Offices, Building 10

The format of the Ballot Paper will be available by Wednesday 5 October from the R.O

Form of Name to appear on Ballot Paper.

You may have your given names shown as (a) the name; (b) an initial standing for the name; or (c) a commonly accepted variation of the name.

CANDIDATE BIOGRAPHIES and PHOTOGRAPHS

A Candidate may lodge with their Nomination a Biography, in English with a maximum of 250 words.

(500 words for positions of President & Ed Vice Pres.)

This should be confined to a description of you and your aims, objectives or policies.

Name, address and contact details will not be counted in the word limit. All that you provide will be published for Voter Information and contact in Election Statements.

The R.O will edit comments about persons or information considered false, misleading or defamatory.

A Photograph (Head and Shoulders) may be submitted, but must include a signed statement that the photo is of the candidate.

ELECTION STATEMENTS

Candidates biographies will be published as "Election Statements" that will be on notice boards and available to the electors when voting. Copies will also be available from Guild Offices and posted on the Guild Website.

Scrutineers

A candidate may appoint in writing one scrutineer who may attend and observe the counting of the ballot papers.
