CANDIDATE BIOGRAPHIES and PHOTOGRAPHS

A Candidate may lodge with their Nomination a Biography, in English with a maximum of 250 words. This should be confined to a description of you and your aims, objectives or policies.

Name, address and contact details will not be counted in the word limit. All that you provide will be published for Voter Information and contact in Election Statements.

The R.O will edit comments about persons or information considered false, misleading or defamatory.

A Photograph (Head and Shoulders) may be submitted, but must include a signed statement that the photo is of the candidate.

ELECTION BROADSHEET

Candidates Nominating under the extended Nominations will only have their biographies and photos at the Polling Place as per the Election Rules.

Scrutineers

A candidate may appoint in writing one scrutineer who may attend and observe the counting of the ballot papers.
