ELECTION NOTICE

Nominations are called from eligible candidates for the election of:

University Council – Two (2) Enrolled Students – term to expire 10 October 2012.

Nominations will be accepted from Wednesday 3 August 2011.

Nomination forms are to be completed in accordance with the *Edith Cowan University Statute No. 28* and must reach the Returning Officer no later than **12.00 noon on Wednesday 24 August 2011**.

Candidate statement: In accordance with Section 6(c) of the *Edith Cowan University Statute No. 28*, included with the nomination form may be a statement in the English language not exceeding 150 words in length. The statement must be presented on a single A4 page and confined to a description of the person and of the person's aims, objectives and/or policies, and which does not contain comments about any other person or information that the Returning Officer considers to be false, misleading or defamatory. The statement must also include the candidate's full name and details of where and how he or she can be contacted.
