

SOUTH WEST CAMPUS ADVISORY BOARD NOTICE OF ELECTION

An election is now being held, and nominations are hereby called, for **1 general staff member** elected from and by the general staff employed at the Campus [Statute 20, Section 3(e)]

The South West Campus (Bunbury) Advisory Board considers a wide range of matters of strategic importance to the Faculty of Regional Professional Studies and South West Campus.

The Board comprises 10 external members, 2 ex-officio members, and 4 elected members: a student member, an academic staff member, a general staff member, and an academic staff member elected by the Academic Board.

The Advisory Board's draft governance functions describe the Advisory Board's role in relation to the provision of advice concerning:

- i. the quality and appropriateness to the needs of the South West region of course offerings, including new courses and continuing education programs
- ii. research and research training
- iii. enhancing relationships with relevant South West Bodies, including precinct partners, TAFE, schools, industry and government agencies
- iv. enhancing community engagement and outreach activities
- v. the promotion and development of the ECU SW Campus, including fundraising
