
## School of Arts and Humanities 2016 Talus Prize for Prose and Poetry





The 2016 Talus Prize for Prose and Poetry is open to all ECU undergraduate students. Entries are due by 4pm Wednesday 12 October 2016. First Prize in each category: \$100.00 with 'Highly Commended' and 'Commended' certificates and book prizes awarded in each category at the judges' discretion. Prizes will be announced on Wednesday 26th October and winners will be published on the ECU website.

## **Conditions of Entry**

Please Note: Entries which do not follow these guidelines will not be eligible for the 2016 Talus Awards.

- · Work is be original and unpublished, and will not have received an award in any other competition.
- Limit of two submissions per author in each category.
   Prose maximum 600 words, Poetry maximum 20 lines per poem for each entry.
- Entries must be typed, double-spaced on one side only of A4 white paper, with pages numbered, and the work's title on each page.
- To ensure anonymity your name must not appear on the manuscript. Please attach a cover sheet with the title of the entry, section entered and word count for prose or number of lines for poetry.
- On a separate sheet note the name and date of the competition (i.e. ECU Talus Prize 2016) together with the title and word/line count of the piece, and your name, student number, and contact details (email and postal addresses as well as telephone numbers).
- Manuscripts will be destroyed after the competition, so please keep a copy.
- · Results will be posted on the School of Arts and Humanities website.
- The winners may be invited to read an excerpt from their work and/or publish their work in a school publication.
- The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- There is no entry fee for this competition.
