

Exercise and Sport Science Study Tour in Taiwan

24 November to 7 December 2018

Sign up for an extraordinary opportunity in Taiwan!

During this study tour, first-year Exercise and Sport Science students will study at the National Taiwan University of Sport (NTUS) and learn how exercise and sport science is taught and applied in Taiwan. They will gain an insight into Taiwanese culture, specifically how the culture influences exercise and sport science. Activities will include participating in

classes such as Chinese martial arts, adventure activities (e.g. mountaineering or canyoneering), dragon dancing, badminton and other sports that are not common in Australia. Students will undertake a research project on a topic of interest, which includes investigating differences between health and exercise science in Taiwan and Australia.

Students can attract credit towards their degree through the Study Tour unit, International Project (HST3505) or an alternative unit approved by the relevant course coordinator.

This program is supported by University Funding and eligible students may also apply for OS-HELP loans to assist with program costs.

Please note that while this program is aimed at first year students, second and third years may also apply.

Applications are now open and close on 3 August 2018.
