

School of Business and Law Work-Integrated Learning Business Internship Program

Could your organisation benefit from having a motivated and enthusiastic Business student for 16 weeks on a full-time basis?

Do you have any projects or tasks that require dedicated attention?

The ECU School of Business and Law is offering WA organisations the opportunity to host final year students in their businesses. Public, private and not-for-profit organisations of any size and across all sectors are invited to participate. Payment terms, if any, are negotiated between the host and the student. ECU covers insurances for any unpaid component of the Internship.

Participating students are vetted through an application process and may come from a range of majors, including Accounting, Finance, Management, Project Management, International Business, HRM, Marketing and Events Management.

The Internship Program runs twice per year, February to May and July to October. Expressions of interest are gathered all year round but matching students to workplace opportunities takes place between October and December for the February program and May to June for the July program.

Students are assigned an ECU academic coordinator who tracks progress, liaises with the workplace supervisor and assesses the students. Assessments include developing a skills e-portfolio and a work-based project. Students will achieve academic credit for participating in the Internship Program.

Host organisations commit to providing a safe workplace with a supervisor who is suitably qualified to mentor and guide the student during their internship.
