



Business and Sustainability Study Tour to Bhutan

Sign up for an extraordinary opportunity in Bhutan!

Bhutan is a small kingdom located in the Himalayas and it prides itself on having the highest gross national happiness in the world.

Undergraduate students from the School of Science or the School of Business and Law are invited to apply for this study tour, based at Royal Thimpu College in Thimpu, Bhutan. Students will undertake collaborative group project work relevant to a sustainability or business discipline associated with their course of study. They will gain first-hand experience of environmental, cultural, social, political and economic factors influencing the way sustainability and business issues are managed in the region.

Students will be able to attract 15 credit points towards their degree, through study tour units International Science Project ISS3101 or Business Study Tour BUS3700 – there are 16 places available.

The Australian Government, through the New Colombo Plan Mobility Program, is supporting this tour and eligible students will receive \$3,000 to assist with their program costs. Students selected must be Australian citizens and will be Ambassadors for Australia. Under the funding program, the tour is open to students over the age of 18 years, however, 70% of students must be 28 years old or under. (Please note that this age restriction does not apply to Indigenous Students.) Eligible students may also apply for OS-Help loans to assist with program costs.

Applications open: 2 November 2017

Applications close: 9 March 2018
