ELECTION INFORMATION FOR STUDENT CANDIDATES

Information for candidates nominating for the position of a currently enrolled student of the South West Campus on the ECU South West Campus (Bunbury) Advisory Board.

Introduction

This information is produced for the benefit of all potential student candidates in the election. More detailed information may be found in [ECU Statute No. 20](#).

Qualifications

A candidate must be a currently enrolled student of Edith Cowan University's South West Campus. A candidate's principal employment (if any) must not be that of a member of staff of the University.

If the candidate who is elected to the Advisory Board ceases to be an enrolled student of the Campus during the term of his or her Advisory Board membership, his or her membership of the Advisory Board will be terminated.

Term of office

Term of office will be from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019.

Important dates in 2018

- Thurs 20 Sept: nominations open
- **Wed 17 Oct at 12noon: nominations close**
- Wed 31 Oct: polling concludes
- Thurs 1 Nov: results declared

Nominations

Nomination forms may be obtained from the web at <http://www.ecu.edu.au/centres/strategic-and-governance-services/our-services/elections>, from the Returning Officer (see bottom right), or from the Dean's Office, Building 1, South West Campus.

The closing date for nominations is 12noon on Wednesday 17 October 2018. The nomination form must be received by the Returning Officer by the close of nominations. Nominations may be submitted by mail, by fax, or in person. Details are on the nomination form.

Self-nomination is permissible. Please ensure both the Proposer and Candidate sections are fully completed. Candidates' details are confidential until the close of nominations.

Each candidate is encouraged to contact the Returning Officer prior to the closing date to confirm that his or her nomination has been received.

Ballot papers

Candidates appear on the ballot in the order established at the ballot draw. The ballot draw will be conducted on Thursday 18 October 2018, and candidates will be notified of the draw result shortly thereafter by email.

Candidate biographies

Each candidate is strongly encouraged to lodge with his or her nomination a biography or election statement. This should be confined to a description of the candidate and his or her aims, objectives or policies. A 150-word limit applies.

Election statements

Candidates' biographies and contact details will be published as Election Statements. These will appear on the ECU website, and will be available to electors when voting.

Polling

Polling, if required, will be conducted electronically, and will conclude on Wednesday 31 October 2018. Full details will be advised following the close of nominations.

Returning Officer

The Returning Officer appointed for this election is Rajes Shenton of University Governance in Strategic and Governance Services (Joondalup Campus). The Returning Officer is responsible for the conduct of the election including:

- nominations;
- production and security of ballots;
- candidates' election statements;
- polling arrangements;
- counting of the votes.
