Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts (WAAPA) fourth year Honours/Masters dance students are invited to apply for a 30-day study tour to Marseille, Montpellier, and Amsterdam. Students will perform for European audiences and experience different performative spaces, cultures and contexts. They will perform and participate in master classes and workshops, learning from leading professionals in the dance industry whilst observing cutting edge contemporary dance performances.

Performance opportunities for the tour include: Fête de la Danse, Marseille Movement Sur La Ville, Montpellier and the Openluchttheater, Amsterdam.

Marseille: LINK will create a new site specific work in collaboration with Companie Itinerances for Fête de la Danse.

Montpellier: Students will participate on invitation in Mouvement Sur La Ville during the Montpellier Danse Festival, performing at the premises of the Didier Theron Dance Company.

Amsterdam: Students will perform in Vondelpark's Openluchttheater and observe performances in Julidans Festival whilst having the opportunity to participate in workshops with renowned international teachers at Henny Jurriens Dance Foundation's Summer Dance Intensive.

Study Tour unit is: Special Topics 2 DAN5105 (20 Credit points).

The Australian Government, through the Endeavour Mobility Grants Program, is supporting this tour and eligible students will receive \$2,000 to assist with their program costs.
