Reading room numbers

There are over 75 buildings and 600 lecture and tutorial rooms across our three campuses!

To help you find your way, we use lots of abbreviations.

For starters: JO means Joondalup. ML is Mount Lawley and BU is our Bunbury campus.

Room numbers indicate the building number, followed by a full-stop and then the level and room numbers combined.

For example, Building 7, Level 2 and Room 16 on our Joondalup campus would be represented as JO7.216.

Please use the map provided at the back of this booklet as a guide, and if you are ever unsure of where to go, our helpful ECU staff and students will point you in the right direction.

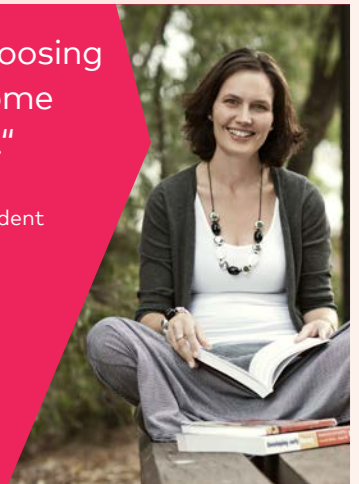

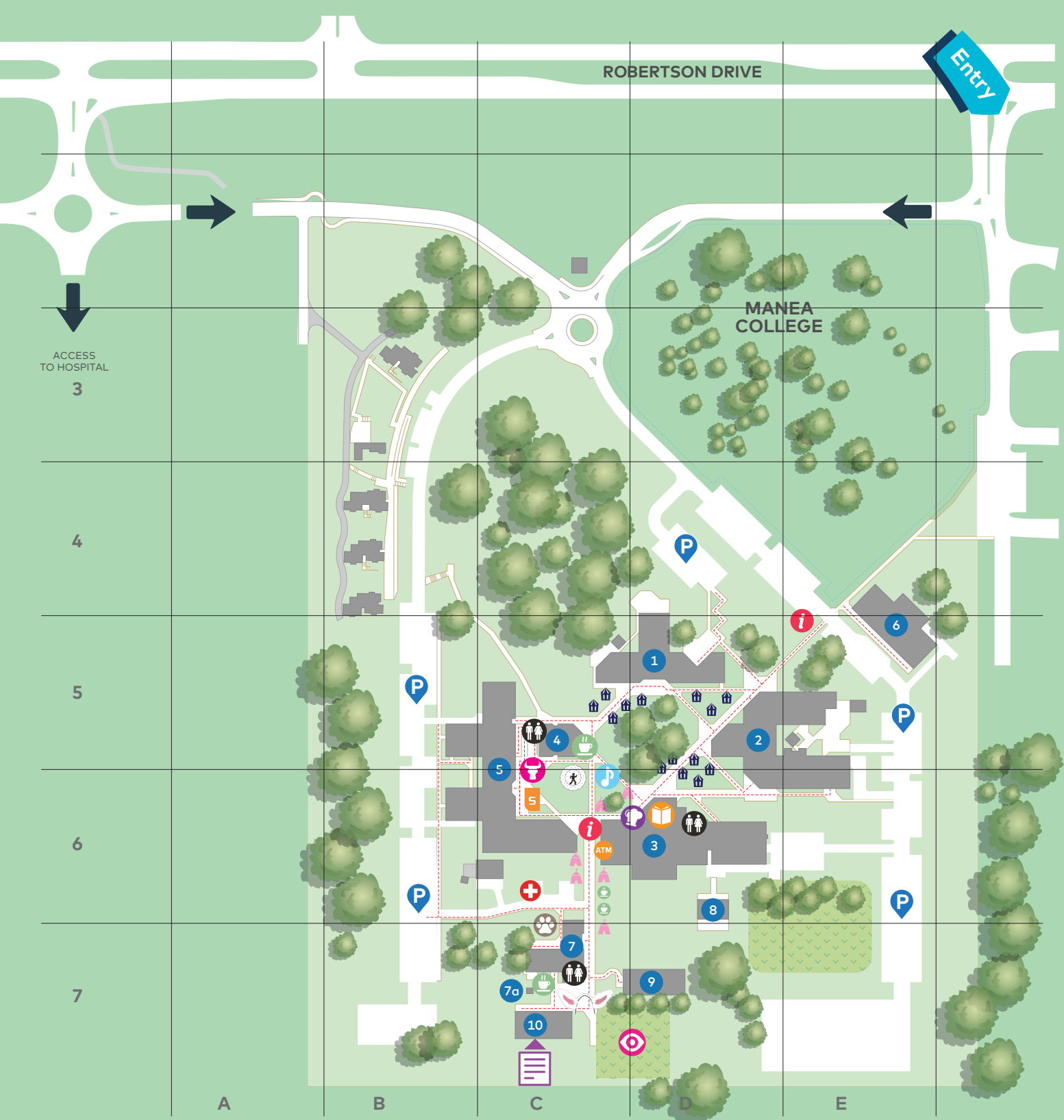
