



Community and Cultural Development Study Tour to Mongolia

27 June – 14 July 2017

Be part of an extraordinary cultural and service experience in Mongolia

Undergraduate students from the School of Arts and Humanities are invited to apply for this unique study tour to Mongolia. The focus of the study tour program is to experience the Mongolian culture and to undertake community service while gaining international experience relating to their undergraduate degree.

Mongolia is a multi-party democracy bordering China and Russia with a unique culture, language and heritage. The country is in the process of industrialisation and aims to combine modernisation with the preservation of traditional culture. Emergent issues include internal migration as well as children and young people moving to urban areas for education or employment without parents/families.

Students from other disciplines within the School, including Arts, Media, Communication and Design, are encouraged to apply as the opportunity to work in multi-disciplinary teams will be an outcome of this experience. In-country support will be provided by ECU academics and an interpreter.

Students will be able to attract credit towards their degree. The Study Tour unit has the potential to be counted as an elective, which will be individually negotiated.

The Australian Government, through the New Colombo Plan Mobility Program, is supporting this tour and 10 eligible students will receive up to \$3,000 to assist with their program costs (eligibility requirements apply).
