

Listing of Research Project Groupings for the Allocation of Scholarships in the Mid-Year Round, 2014



Points will be allocated to each applicant on the basis of the research topic chosen. Close alignment of a topic with a priority research area will attract at least 3 points. Some of the priority areas will be deemed “high”, attracting 5 points. Research topics not otherwise in a defined priority but nonetheless aligning with the recent research outputs of the principal supervisor will attract 1 point.

Research priority areas are determined by the Vice-Chancellor’s Planning and Management Group (VCPMG) and periodically revised. A current listing will be available in association with scholarship application forms.

Group A* (High Priority)

(Endorsed by the VCPMG based on the strategic importance of the areas for the University’s scholarship programs).
