

How to access *Medline* (and other databases).

To access *Medline*, or any other database, start at the ECU home page.

From here you can choose to go through the student portal or you can connect via the library home page. It doesn't matter which option you use.

Access via Student Portal

To go through the Student Portal – click on the link **MetaQuest** which is located under **Easy Logins**.

At this point you can search for a particular database by **title** or, if you wish to see the range of databases available, you can search by **subject**.

If you choose subject, click on **health sciences**. This will result in a menu listing all the sub-categories available. Choose **medicine** and click on the **GO** button. The result will be a list of 27 relevant databases.

For a comprehensive, detailed search we recommend that you search the databases one at a time but if you want to search several databases at once, click on the link **MetaSearch** and select up to 10 databases.

Access via Library Home Page

You can access the databases via the **Library** link found at the bottom of the ECU home page. From there you can access the databases by title and subject, or you can do a search across multiple databases.

Access problems

Sometimes there is a problem with access through MetaQuest. If this occurs, enter the database title in the library catalogue.
