



# Community and Cultural Engagement in Bhutan

This three-week program is open to both undergraduate and post-graduate students, and focusses on community, language, and cultural engagement in a country that strives for Gross National Happiness. Students will:

- Interact with national agencies and communities to understand the impact of modernisation on the country's richly traditionalist culture.

- Focus on the cultural context of social issues relevant to their studies.

- Attend intensive language classes and be supported by local buddies at the Royal University of Bhutan, Samtse College.

- Visit culturally significant sites.

Undergraduate students will gain credit towards the unit Cross-Cultural Knowledge and Global Citizenship (SAH2100).
