A MARS initiative to track and improve psychosocial safety and wellbeing at work.

Workplaces have a growing responsibility to protect their people from psychosocial risks. However, to make meaningful progress, organisations need the right tools.

The Better Together Platform is a digital tool that helps mining workplaces understand and improve their teams' psychosocial safety. It captures site- and team-level data, tracks changes over time, and benchmarks results against the wider industry.

Based on what your teams report, the platform provides simple, targeted recommendations to improve performance and create a healthier, more respectful work culture.
