- Be completing Year 12 studies (WACE or an equivalent program) in the year you apply.
- Satisfy admission requirements for your intended Engineering Bachelor course*.
- Not be in receipt of any other merit-based scholarship from ECU.
- Plan to be a full-time student studying on-campus at ECU Joondalup.

* Non eligible courses are: Bachelor of Technology (Aeronautical); Bachelor of Engineering Honours/Bachelor of Commerce; Bachelor of Engineering Honours/Bachelor of Science; and Bachelor of Engineering (Computer Systems) Honours/Bachelor of Computer Science.

1. Two reference letters from either your school principal, academic advisor, teacher or workplace manager.
2. A 500-word essay to address each of the statements below:
 - a. Demonstrate how you live ECU's values of Integrity, Respect, Rational Inquiry, Personal Excellence and Courage.
 - b. Discuss how engineering is important in your community.
