Biography

Greg Molloy is an Irish born artist (1994), who has been active in numerous exhibitions in WA since he graduated from Curtin University with a Bachelor of Arts in 2019.

Molloy has had had recent success with awards in the City of Bayswater and City of South Perth sculpture prizes, and acquiring a Department of Local Government, Sport and Culture grant to pursue an exhibition at Spectrum Project Space and other projects that will be active in more exhibitions during 2021. In early 2022 he will make his first appearance in Sculptures at Bathers.

Molloy is the Curator and Director of two recently established Artist Run Initiatives (ARI's) since January 2021. INTOO studios and ROOK ARI are spaces that support the future development of artists.



Artist Statement

BEASTS delves into ideas and processes that develop into artworks where one could consider the work to be a Beast. Taming industrial materials. Repetitious processes that potentially lead to the infinite. Alluring encounters with tall quadrupedal grim figures. Time disorientating sound scapes. Hybridisation of anatomical and mechanical.

Throughout my studies and working life I combined all the skills I found in contemporay art practice from University, event management, furniture restoration and construction based environments of making. This constant adapting to new working environments has formed a dynamic practice that incorporates kinetic sculpture, interactive sound installations, print, drawing and performance.

My work interrogates the space with sound and form as large post industrial kinetic sculptures that hybridise methods in fabrication and production present in stop-motion animation, absurd theatre, industrial mid century furniture, musical instrument construction. I'm testing environments with my machines to create layered profound experiences for the viewer.
