Be part of an exciting SBL study tour in Sri Lanka!

This management program, run by the School of Business and Law, is hosted by one of Sri Lanka's famous national universities, the University of Sri Jayewardenepura (USJP), with the support of the Faculty of Applied Sciences, the top Faculty of Management Studies and Commerce, and the Centre for Sustainability.

Students will join workshops, classes, and field visits focused on sustainability and climate change. They will study management policies, accounting practices, sustainability initiatives, and the application of United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals by Sri Lankan organisations.

The program includes cultural immersion, Sinhalese language learning, and exploring Sri Lanka's economy and political landscape.

- Attend pre-language classes locally and visit ECU's Sri Lanka campus.
- Visit the MJF Charitable Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Dilmah Ceylon Tea Services and Resplendent Ceylon.
- Take a cultural tour to Sri Lanka's few tourist sites.

Students will gain 15 credit points through the unit International Business Study Tour (INB3700).
