

## Travel and Accommodation information

The ECU\_AIESEP Specialist Seminar is being held at <u>Edith Cowan University's South West (ECU SW) Campus</u> located near **Bunbury** in **Western Australia**.

If you are travelling from inter-state or internationally to attend the seminar, we recommend an extended stay in WA © – enabling you to see Perth and surrounds either before or after spending time at the specialist seminar and in the <u>South West</u> of our beautiful state. <u>Bunbury</u> is the regional centre for the South West and a gateway to some amazing coastal areas, renowned local food and wine, and much more.

**If traveling from inter-state**, your options are to fly into **Perth Airport** or fly into **Busselton-Margaret River airport**.

## **Getting from Perth to Bunbury**

**Bunbury** is approximately 2 hours drive from Perth – a good road trip, or public transport is available direct from Perth airport or from Perth city.

If you are able to self-drive, there are direct and more scenic options. Please get in touch for more information and ideas for stops on the way, such as the <u>Giants of Mandurah</u>.

<u>South West Coach Lines</u> operate express coach services to the south-west. Services direct to Bunbury are available from both airport terminals, and from Elizabeth Quay bus station in Perth.

If you are intending to travel from Perth to the Specialist Seminar on **Monday 8 December 2025**, you will need to get the **7.30am service from Elizabeth Quay to the Bunbury Health Campus** stop. (see *Perth-Busselton via Bunbury route* for this option). ECU SW campus is adjacent to the Bunbury Health Campus.

The **Australind Train service** from Perth to Bunbury is currently undergoing a major upgrade. It may be back in service by December and we will advise when re-opening is confirmed.





## **Your stay in Bunbury**

Bunbury has a range of accommodation available centrally located and adjacent to Koombana Bay, which will be a focal point for social activities. Several <u>tourism sites</u> offer assistance with bookings for visitors, with consultants available at <u>Bunbury Visitor Centre</u>.
