Prizes

Entering the Open Day Registration Competition

- 2. To enter the Competition, you must complete and submit the registration form located at https://www.ecu.edu.au/open-day/overview
- 3. Only registrations occurring between 07/03/2024 at 12.00pm (AWST) until 28/04/2024 at 3.00pm (AWST) will be accepted as entries into the Competition.
