Terms of Reference (UC224/15 Dec23)

- Recommend to Council amendments to the ECU Act or the adoption, amendment or repeal of University Statutes, Rules and By-Laws necessary or advisable for the effective governance of the University.
- 2. Provide advice on both the content/intent of the proposed changes as well as the form of the proposed changes.
- 3. Where necessary and appropriate ensure that legal advice is obtained in relation to any changes to the ECU Act, University Statutes, Rules or By-Laws recommended to Council.
- 4. Provide advice to Council on the establishment and maintenance of the University's policy and procedural frameworks, including the development and amendment of relevant Council-approved policies in accordance with the *Matters to be Reserved to Council*.
- 5. Report to Council on such matters as may be referred to it by the Council, the Chancellor or the Vice-Chancellor.
- 6. Make decisions on matters delegated to the Committee by Council.
