During this tour you will have the opportunity to attend academic and cultural talks alongside students from the University of Sri Jayewardenepura. This will be an unforgettable experience that will enrich your cultural knowledge and skills, offer you a chance to apply your medical and health science knowledge in a real-world setting, and provide credit towards your degree.

As part of the program, students will enroll into unit HST3505 International Study Project.

The Australian Government's New Colombo Plan (NCP) supports this project, and we have twenty places available. Eligible students will receive a \$3,000 NCP grant to help cover the program costs.

Students must have completed at least 180 credit points, must be Australian Citizens and will represent both Australia and ECU as ambassadors. Under the funding program, 70% of students must be between 18 to 28 years of age at the start of the project. Please note that this age restriction does not apply to Indigenous Students.
