



Fiji Planetary Health International Mobility Program

Be part of an exciting School of Science Program in Fiji!

This program is run by the School of Science and hosted by Fiji National University (FNU). ECU undergraduate students with an interest in Planetary Health are invited to apply. Students will draw together theory and practical experience on current environmental and health issues of importance to Fiji and compare these to their own experiences in Australia. The program builds on the Watershed Interventions for Systems Health (WISH) research program.

Students will attend seminars by project partners including FNU, WISH Fiji, the World Health Organisation (WHO) and Fiji Ministry of Health. They will gain an understanding of the political and cultural framework which governs Fiji's society.

Students will gain credit towards the International Science Project Unit (ISS3101), or an approved alternative unit.

10 eligible students will receive a \$3000 grant via the Australian Government's New Colombo Plan.

Grant recipients must be Australian citizens and will be Ambassadors for both Australia and ECU.
