

ARC Advanced Life Support Level 1: Immediate Life Support Course



Course outline

This course is advanced life support for the immediate period of crisis. It is aimed at those participating as team members in critical events. To train healthcare personnel in causes and prevention of cardiopulmonary arrest, the ABCDE approach, initial resuscitation and defibrillation (manual and/or AED) and airway management.

Requirements

The course curriculum assumes that participants have an understanding of Basic Life Support (BLS) and have undertaken professional training in a healthcare related profession such as medicine or nursing.

Course format and duration

This one day course will enable all participants to have the opportunity to participate in the management of simulated emergency scenarios. Strict confidentiality is maintained.
