Terms and Conditions

Prizes

1. There are 12 GiftPay Flexi eGift Cards with a value of AU\$50.00 to be won in connection with Edith Cowan University’s (ECU’s) “Scan to Win” competition (**Competition**).

Opening and closing dates

2. The Competition opens at 9:00am (AWST) on 24 July 2019.
3. The Competition closes at 5:00pm (AWST) on 9 July 2020.

How to enter

4. To enter the Competition you must:
 - (a) attend an event hosted by ECU and be issued a “Scan to Win” competition card; and
 - (b) scan the QR code on the “Scan to Win” competition card or visit the URL provided and enter the Competition by completing the required details and submitting your entry.
5. By completing and submitting your Competition entry, you will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions or, if you are under the age of 18, you will be deemed to have obtained your parent or guardian’s consent to enter the Competition and be bound by these terms and conditions.
6. All employees of ECU (including full time, part time and casual employees) and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the Competition.
7. A person who has won a prize in the Competition is not eligible to enter the Competition again in a subsequent month.
8. ECU is entitled at its sole and absolute discretion to reject or disqualify any entry which it determines to be incomplete or ineligible or which in the sole opinion of ECU contains unlawful, defamatory, offensive or other material which if published or broadcast would place the business interests of ECU at risk or adversely affect the goodwill, name or reputation of ECU.

Prize draw

9. Each prize will be drawn at ECU’s Joondalup Campus, located at 270 Joondalup Drive, Joondalup WA.
10. A prize draw will be conducted on the 10th day of each month in respect of which the Competition is run. If the 10th day of a month falls on a Saturday, Sunday or ECU-observed public holiday, the prize draw will be conducted on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or ECU-observed public holiday.
11. The first prize draw will be conducted on Monday, 12 August 2019. Entries will be valid for this draw if they are received by ECU between 9:00am (AWST) on 24 July 2019 and midnight (AWST) on 11 August 2019.
12. In relation to each subsequent prize draw (other than the final draw), entries may be submitted from 12:01am (AWST) on the date of the previous draw until midnight (AWST) on the date immediately prior to the date of the next draw.

13. The last prize draw will be conducted on 10 July 2020. Entries will be valid for this draw if they are received by ECU between 12:01am (AWST) on 10 June 2020 and midnight (AWST) on 9 July 2020.
14. Following a monthly draw, all unsuccessful entries will be destroyed and will not be eligible for the next month's draw.
15. An ECU representative will select winners via a random draw. The winner is not required to be present at the draw.
16. ECU's decision as to each winner is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the result of any draw.
17. Each winner will be notified by email or telephone within 7 days from the draw date each month.
18. If the winner does not respond to ECU within 60 days, the winner is taken to have forfeited their prize and the winning selection will be made redundant.
19. All unclaimed prizes remain the property of ECU.
20. Prizes are not transferable, not extendable, cannot be redeemed for cash and are not valid in conjunction with any other offer.
21. ECU accepts no responsibility for any prizes that are lost in transit, misplaced, misdirected or late.
