

ECU Global Virtual Open Day 2021 Terms and Conditions

Prize

1. By entering the ECU Global Virtual Open Day 2021 competition (**Competition**) you will have a chance to win one (1) iPad (valued at A\$499) (**Prize**).

Entering the Competition

2. To enter the Competition, you must:
 - a. register your details at ECU's Global Virtual Open Day 2021 at globalopenday.ecu.edu.au; and
 - b. log in and engage with the content (for example viewing webinars/videos, asking questions, visiting booths, downloading materials) on ECU's Global Virtual Open Day 2021 between 11am and 5pm (AWST) on 7 May, 2021.
3. A person can only enter the Competition once.
4. If you are under the age of 17 years (inclusive), you must obtain parental or guardian consent to enter the Competition. Parents or guardians may be required to enter into a further agreement with ECU if you win the Prize.
5. The Competition is not open to:
 - c. Employees of ECU and their immediate families;
 - d. companies, agencies or individuals associated with the Competition;

9. The winner will need to claim their Prize by no later than 16 July, 2021 by providing a valid shipping address. ECU may require a winner to provide identification documents to verify their identity.

 - g. cannot be notified that they have won a Prize by 30 May 2021; or
 - h. does not collect their Prize by 16 July, 2021,

Prizes will remain the property of ECU. ECU may elect to repeat this process until the Prize is collected.
