Course Highlights

- On Country Experience: Begin with a visit to a site of significance, guided by Elders, to reflect on the connection between place, culture, and identity.
- Culturally Responsive Pedagogy: Learn to incorporate Aboriginal knowledge and histories into your teaching, enriching your and your students' cultural understanding.
- Interactive Workshops: Participate in engaging activities like reflective yarning, group discussions, and hands-on learning to infuse Aboriginal perspectives into your curriculum.

Course Facilitators

The course is facilitated by three experts from ECU's School of Education; **Dr Libby Jackson-Barrett**, a Nyungar Educator and researcher specialising in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander education and culturally responsive pedagogies; **Associate Professor Matt Byrne**, an experienced educator and researcher in Aboriginal education and community-based health and education; and **Associate Professor Helen Adam** a researcher focused on socially just education and the use of inclusive literature to challenge societal prejudices.
