Tokyo Creative Journey is a 3-week program offered by **Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU)** in the summer of 2026. The program provides opportunities to **learn Japanese language** and **explore Japanese culture**. Participants will discover the creativity of Japan, from traditional arts to cutting-edge technology, while deepening their understanding of the city of Tokyo and TMU.

Location: Tokyo Metropolitan University (Minami-Osawa Campus)

Summer Program: June 22 (Mon) – July 8 (Wed), 2026 (tentative)

Participants: 20–30 students

Program Fee: Approx. 150,000 JPY

(included: Accommodation during the program, Textbooks, Admission fees for field studies and workshops)
Tuition is waived for partner university students.

Japanese Language Classes: Practical, communication-focused lessons.

Levels offered (Summer): Beginner (A1), Elementary 1 (A2.1), Elementary 2 (A2.2)

Tokyo Studies: Explore Tokyo through lectures, workshops, and study tours.

Sample Topics: History of Edo/Tokyo, Traditional arts (e.g., Japanese graphic arts), Contemporary art & Technology or Pop culture (manga, film, etc.)

Cultural Activities: (TBD)

Visits to historical sites (e.g., Kawasaki Open-Air Museum, or Hama-rikyu Gardens)

Traditional cultural experiences (e.g., tea ceremony, calligraphy, judo or kendo)

Exchange events with TMU students (Tanabata Festival, or sports activities)

Certificate of Completion: Participants will be evaluated based on class participation, activities, and presentations. A certificate of completion will be awarded.
