

## Edith Cowan University – Open Day

### Unlock a Prize Competition

### Terms and Conditions

#### Prizes

2. There is one (1) prize pool for all three (3) Edith Cowan University on-campus Open Days in 2024.
3. Unclaimed prizes at the first Open Day will then be allocated to the second Open Day. Unclaimed prizes at the second Open Day will then be allocated to the third Open Day. Unclaimed prizes at the third and final Open Day for 2024 will then remain the property of Edith Cowan University.

## Entering The “Unlock A Prize” Open Day Competition

4. To enter the Competition, you must:
  - a. Attend an on-campus Edith Cowan University Open Day in 2024 and search the campus or attend talks and demonstrations to be allocated prize cards.
  - b. Each prize card will feature a unique colour and 4-digit pin.
  - c. Visit the competition headquarters and use the unique numbers on your cards to try and open the corresponding-coloured locked box.
  - d. If the lock opens, you win the prize inside that box.
5. You may only use the combinations listed on the prize cards that you locate. No other combinations may be entered.
6. Note that available prizes will vary by campus. There is one (1) prize pool for all three (3) ECU on-campus Open Days.
7. Coloured prize cards can only be used on the corresponding colour-coded prize box.
8. Prize cards can only be obtained and used at the following three (3) ECU Open Day events:

9. If you are under the age of 17 years (inclusive), you must obtain parental or guardian consent to enter the Competition. Parents or guardians may be required to enter into a further agreement with Edith Cowan University if you win a Prize.
10. The Competition is not open to:
  - a. Employees of ECU;
  - b. Volunteers and any other members of staff working at the Open Days;
  - c. companies, agencies or individuals associated with the Competition;
  - d. any person where that person or anyone from the same family or household has won a prize or prizes from ECU in the 60 days prior to the commencement of the Competition; or
  - e. any person who is discovered to have used or attempted to use any more than one name in order to qualify to win, except in the case of a legal change of name.

## Claiming Prizes

11. The Prize must be claimed by the winner on the day it is won unless otherwise stated in this agreement.
12. If a winner is unable to claim their Prize on the day it is won due to extenuating circumstances such as unforeseen events or emergencies, the winner must notify the organisers immediately to arrange an alternate collection time.
13. The alternate collection time for the Prize shall be no later than 12:00pm Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on 10 May 2024.
14. Failure to claim the Prize within the specified timeframe may result in forfeiture of the Prize, and the Prize will remain the property of Edith Cowan University.
15. The winner is responsible for arranging their own transportation and logistics for Prize collection, unless explicitly stated otherwise by the organisers.
16. The Prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and cannot be redeemed for cash or any other form of compensation.
17. The organisers reserve the right to verify the identity and eligibility of the winner before awarding the Prize.
18. All unclaimed Prizes remain the property of ECU.
19. ECU accepts no responsibility for any lost, misplaced or misdirected Prizes.

## General Conditions

20. Entry and other instructions contained within promotional material form part of these terms and conditions.
21. By participating in the Competition, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
22. ECU is entitled at its sole discretion to reject or disqualify any entry which it determines to be incomplete or ineligible or which in the sole opinion of ECU contains unlawful, defamatory, offensive or other material which if published or broadcast would place the business interests of ECU at risk or adversely affect the goodwill, name or reputation of ECU.
23. ECU reserves the right to refuse Prize redemption to any participant that does not comply with these terms and conditions.

24. By entering the competition, you agree, to have your name, and any photographs of you taken by ECU or its agents published on ECU's website or social media channels for promotional, marketing, publicity, research, or profiling purposes. You grant to ECU a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free licence to reproduce, communicate, adapt, modify and publish your name or any photographs of you taken by ECU or its agents, for the purposes of marketing, promotion and publicity.
25. To the fullest extent permitted by law, ECU absolves itself of any and all liability, financial or resultant arising out of, or in connection with the Competition.
26. To the fullest extent permitted by law, you release from, and indemnify ECU against, all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of acceptance of any Prize or participation in the Competition including (but not limited to) loss of income, personal injury and damage to property and whether direct or consequential, foreseeable, due to some negligent act or omission or otherwise.
27. These terms and conditions are subject to change at the discretion of the organisers, and any updates will be communicated to the participants.
