Engineering Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is Gravy Gaming (ABN: 17 603 435 203) whose registered office is Level 4, 15 Ogilvie Road, Mount Pleasant, Western Australia, 6153. (“**the Promoter**”)
2. The secondary promoter is 303 Mullenlowe, located at Level 2, 242 Murray St, Perth, Western Australia, 6000. (“**the Secondary Promoter**”)
3. Entries for the ECU Engineering Hub Competition (“**the Competition**”) will open on Monday 16 September 9am AWST and close on Sunday 20 October 6pm AWST (“**the Promotion Period**”).

Competition specific

4. The major prize is a laptop (choice of Apple MacBook Air or Windows) valued up to \$1,800. The laptop will be awarded to one winner at the end of the promotion period (“**the Major Prize**”).
5. The weekly prize is a \$50 Visa Debit card. The card will be awarded to **one** winner each Monday for a total duration of 5 weeks (to be drawn on the Sunday prior) (“**the Weekly Prize**”). The Weekly Prize will be drawn through this process:
 - a. ECU and the Promoter will select each Weekly Prize winner through a random draw of all the entries that have signed up to the ‘ECU Engineering Hub Competition’ through <https://www.ecu.edu.au/degrees/study-areas/engineering-and-technology/ecu-engineering-hub> at the time of the weekly draw and have completed at least one (1) game.
 - b. The Weekly Prize winner will be notified via the email address and phone number they used to enter the Competition.
 - c. The Weekly Prize winner will have five (5) business days to respond and claim their prize. If the recipient does not respond within 5 business days of the time of notification, the recipient is taken to have forfeited their prize and the winning selection will be made redundant.
 - d. In this case of a recipient forfeiting the prize, a redraw will occur with a new winner randomly selected from all other entries received at the time of the initial draw. The new winner will be contacted as per clauses 5(b) and 5(c) above.
6. The competition is limited to one Weekly Prize per person during the promotion period.
7. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter the Competition.

8. To enter the Major Prize draw:
- a. Visit <https://www.ecu.edu.au/degrees/study-areas/engineering-and-technology/ecu-engineering-hub>. Play various games and earn points to unlock weekly games and increase your total score.
 - b. At the end of each game, entrants will need to sign up to the 'ECU Engineering Hub Competition' by providing their name, email address and phone number in order to go into the draw and be eligible for the Weekly Prize or Major Prize.
 - c. ECU will contact you via email or SMS to notify you when new challenges are unlocked.
 - d. Follow all the prompts to advance through each challenge and enter the Major Prize draw.
 - e. Entrants will receive one (1) entry into the Major Prize draw for each game completed.
9. ECU and the Promoter will select the Major Prize winner by 17:00 AWST on Monday 21 October through a random draw of all the entries that have completed the steps in clause 8(a)-(d).
10. The Major Prize winner will be notified via the email address and phone number they used to enter the Competition.
11. On Tuesday 22 October 2019, the Major Prize winner will be contacted by phone by a representative from Edith Cowan University or the Promoter to claim their prize.
12. The Major Prize winner will have 5 business days to respond and claim their prize. If the recipient does not respond within 5 business days of the time of notification, the recipient is taken to have forfeited their prize and the winning selection will be made redundant.
13. In this case of a recipient forfeiting the prize, a redraw will occur with a new winner randomly selected from all other entries received. The new winner will be contacted as per clause ten (10), and clause twelve (12) above will apply to the new winner.
14. The competition is only open to Australian Citizens, Permanent Residents, Student Visa holders, or holders of a Refugee and Humanitarian Visa. Entrants must have a valid Western Australian residential address to enter the Competition.
15. In the event the prize winner is under eighteen (18) years of age, a parent or guardian must be present in order to claim their prize.
