Conditions of Use

ECU Library is committed to providing a safe, inclusive and productive environment that supports study, research, collaboration, social connection and wellbeing. By entering and using the Library space, facilities and services, all users agree to comply with the following Conditions of Use.

- Food and drink are permitted, but we kindly ask you not to consume them at computer stations and always clean up after yourself.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted within the Library or on any ECU grounds.
- Entry is not permitted if you are under the influence of alcohol or other substances.
- Respect ECU Library facilities, including all equipment, furniture and collections.
- Misuse of computers, networks and electronic resources; and accessing, displaying or transmitting offensive or illegal content is not permitted.
- Look out for the safety and wellbeing of others. Harassment, intimidation, bullying, or victimisation of any kind is not acceptable.
- Respect the diversity and opinions of others. Offensive or derogatory language is not acceptable.
- Respect the directions given by Library staff regarding appropriate use of the space. Disruptive, abusive, or aggressive behaviour is not permitted.
- For safety reasons, the Library is not a place for sleeping, except in designated sleep pods.
- Keep noise to appropriate levels. Quiet, silent, group and project spaces must be used as intended.
- Commercial recording or photography is not permitted without prior permission – please submit a request form.
- Acceptable levels of personal hygiene and dress are required, in the interests of health, safety and comfort of others.
- Children aged under 12 years must be supervised by an adult.
- Do not leave personal belongings unattended. You are responsible for your items at all times. The Library is not liable for loss, theft, damage, or misplacement of belongings. Staff and Security officers have the right to remove unattended bags.
- You may be asked by Security to present a valid university ID card, especially after hours. Anyone without an ECU card may be asked to leave.
- Report any inappropriate, unsafe, or disruptive behaviour to Library staff and/or Security.
