



Global Leadership in Japan

Discover Tokyo and gain a competitive edge in the global employment market.

This four-week program, hosted by Tokyo City University (TCU), focuses on leadership and soft skills development and is open to all undergraduate students at ECU. The program is targeted at students who have demonstrated leadership, particularly through the TCU Buddy Program. Students will be immersed in Japanese culture, language lessons, and history. This program is focused on a transition into the global workplace and includes an internship. Students can get 30 credits through unit SAH3690 Leading for Cultural Understanding. Speak to the Student Hub to see how this, or an alternative, would best fit into your Course Plan. This project is supported by the Australian Government's New Colombo Plan (NCP). To be eligible, you must be an Australian citizen and enrolled in an undergraduate course.

There are 16 places available and eligible students will receive \$5,000 to assist with program costs.

As the number of grants is limited, we encourage students to submit their applications as soon as possible.
