## PPA4311 TEACHING REQUIREMENTS - SEMESTER 1, 2024

The allocation of teaching time for Assistant Teachers (AT) in their final teaching practice is carefully devised to allow a gradual increase in the responsibility for the teaching program. This is to ensure that there are adequate opportunities for Assistant Teachers to observe Mentor Teachers (MT) modelling best teaching practice. Where appropriate, variations from this schedule may be negotiated with the Assistant Teacher and the University Supervisor (US). When Assistant Teachers are not engaged in teaching lessons, they should support the work in the classroom under the direction of the Mentor Teachers. All learning experiences taught in Weeks 1-4 will be supported by the mentor's planning documents and the 8 week learning area program prepared by the Assistant Teacher. Learning experience/Lesson Plans should include a high level of detail.
