ECE6140 HAT GUIDELINES 2026 - ASSESSMENT

University Supervisors (US) will assume the role of monitoring the progress of Pre-services teachers (PST), determining the outcome for the professional experience, and completing the *Interim* and *Final Evaluation Forms*. Pre-service teachers will be evaluated against the seven areas of the National Quality Standard (NQS). **This professional experience is assessed on a PASS/FAIL basis. ECE6140 is a designated unit.** This professional experience unit is deemed to be a fundamental course requirement and may only be attempted once unless otherwise determined by the Progression Panel. Failure to pass these units may result in exclusion from the course.

Mentor Teachers (MT) will provide support, guidance, and feedback throughout the professional experience. This will include discussions with the University Supervisor on the two visits, to assist them completing the *Interim Report and Final Evaluation Forms*. University Supervisors (US) and the relevant centre staff will collaborate to ensure that input from all stakeholders is valued and considered in the decision-making process.

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End Point Day 15	US Visit Final Evaluation Form and Overall Results Form Due	US reviews Professional Experience file: • Contextual information • Observations, planning, and assessment information • Resources (Pre-service teachers are encouraged to have) US will observe implementation of a planned experience and in collaboration with centre staff, determines the final grade for the professional experience. US completes the Final Evaluation Form and Overall Results Form on the final day of the professional experience (day 15) via SONIA.
