



# ECU Sustainability Study Tour in Bhutan

Join a unique two-week study tour to Bhutan, open to all ECU students, and explore sustainability from multiple perspectives. Based at Royal Thimphu College, students will undertake collaborative group projects relevant to their field of study.

Experience Bhutan's globally admired conservation ethos and Gross National Happiness philosophy through immersive fieldwork, expert-led sessions, and cultural engagement. Visit key sites like Phobjikha Valley and the Royal Botanical Park, and explore topics such as biodiversity, climate change, waste management, and sustainable development.

Students will gain firsthand insight into the environmental, cultural, social, political, and economic factors shaping sustainability in Bhutan, and compare these to Australian contexts. The tour promotes critical thinking, intercultural awareness, and practical application of sustainability principles.

Students will gain 15 credits towards ISS3101 International Science Project or another approved unit.
