**Artist's Statement** 

Transports is the debut photography exhibition of musician Eduardo Cossio. The collection

displays a series of images capturing the fluidity of perception while prompting viewers to renegotiate their perception of the world. Echoing his experimental music practice, the

photographs, quiet and contemplative, invite a free-fall into the viewer's imagination.

Eduardo Cossio is one of the most active experimental musicians in Boorloo. His work is concerned with extending the sonic possibilities of acoustic instruments by means of

preparations, non-standard playing techniques, and electronics. Like with his music, Eduardo's

images move between the recognized and the defamiliarized; adopting shifting sightlines to

explore texture, surface, and light in sculptural ways.

This exhibition includes one of his Photo Scores projected in the gallery. The animated video

projection re-interprets his own photographs through visual and musical tropes such as

concrete art, collage techniques, acousmatic practices, and indeterminacy. Eduardo will offer

live realisations of his Photo Scores throughout the exhibition.

**Biography** 

Eduardo Cossio is a Peruvian-Australian musician and photographer based in Boorloo (Perth)

Western Australia.

His compositions highlight the materiality of everyday objects in both intimate and monumental

ways. He draws on his practice as an experimental musician using prepared instruments and

non-standard playing techniques. Like his musical work, his photographs follow sculptural

concerns (texture, surface, light) and a focus on subject matter usually considered peripheral.

Eduardo's photography was selected finalist at the CLIP Award 2022 and his documentary  $\underline{\textit{ln}}$ 

The Thrall Of The Spirit was screened as part of Audible Edge Festival of Sound 2021. He is

also a prolific organiser, broadcaster, and writer in the Perth experimental music community.


