PPA2211 ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE - Semester 1, 2024

University Supervisors will assume the role of monitoring the progress of Pre-service Teachers, determining the final mark for the Professional Experience and completing the Assessment and Evaluation Form. Mentor Teachers will assume the role of Mentor and provide support, guidance and feedback (both written and verbal) throughout the Professional Experience.

University Supervisors and Mentors, together with School Practice Coordinators will collaborate to ensure that input from all stakeholders is valued and considered in the decision-making process. Pre-service Teachers will be evaluated against the National Professional Standards for Teachers in the areas of Professional Knowledge, Professional Experience and Professional Engagement. Monitoring tools are provided to support Mentor Teachers in ensuring that criteria for assessment are clearly addressed throughout the Professional Experience.

Pre-service Teachers will be assessed on a Pass/Fail basis. They will be assessed according to whether or not they have met the requirements of the Professional Experience.

Week 2	Combined School Planning visit and Classroom Visit	University Supervisor comes to the school to collectively meet all Pre-Service Teachers- goes through planning, provide support and answer questions.
	(This applies to schools with one student or the first student at one school with multiple students.)	US then observes individual lessons, completes a Learning Experience Feedback form, reviews all documentation, liaises with Mentor Teacher and views all Mentor Teacher's checklists.
