Build a Team

Aim big! Rember, a team of 15-20 means a full reimbursement on your program and flights and will be a huge achievement. Your Leadership Mentor will provide guidance and ideas.

Team Management

You're not alone! Set a schedule for regular catch ups with your Leadership mentor so that you have continuous support in the lead up to your program.

During:

A dedicated team in-country team member will be there every step of the way as you coordinate group meetings and debriefs, supporting your team throughout their experience. You're also group photographer so we can keep up to date with all the amazing things you do!

After:

Encourage your team to fill out the CAA survey and share your experience with others to inspire future Challenge Leaders.
