- Bespoke multi-modal data collection software that enables an innovative, cost effective and flexible means of capturing and processing questionnaire data.
- An automated telephone dialer system for accuracy and increased efficiency.
- · Recording capability and audio component.
- A bulk SMS messaging system.
- Customised intelligent software allowing pre-coded responses, to assist in accuracy and efficiency, as well as cater for open-ended fields, where required.
- A web interviewing facility.
- Online survey capacity.
- Face-to-face central location interviewing using wireless mobile devices.

Key capabilities


